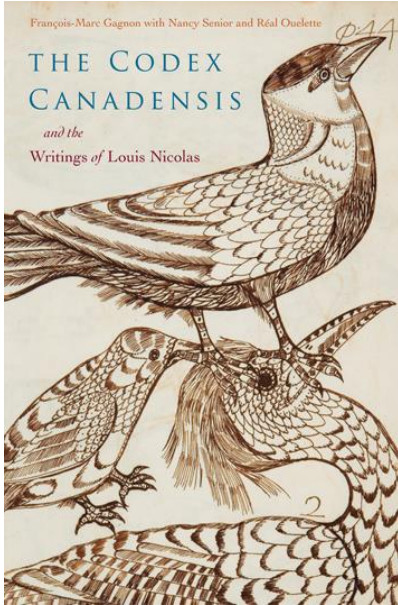


2012 Melva J. Dwyer Award Winner

The Codex Canadensis and the Writings of Louis Nicolas



The 2012 Melva J. Dwyer Award goes to François-Marc Gagnon, Nancy Senior, and Réal Ouellet, for *The Codex Canadensis and the Writings of Louis Nicolas*, published by McGill-Queen's University Press in 2011.

In the words of the jury, "The Codex Canadensis is a remarkable publication through and through. The image reproductions are exemplary and the overall contribution to our knowledge of the visual and material culture of the early colonial mindset is invaluable. The rigorous and meticulous detail of their notations and descriptions of the document demonstrate their authority in an unquestionable manner."

The 2012 award was administered by James Rout, Chair of ARLIS/NA Canada, and a jury that consisted of Vanessa Kam, University of British Columbia; David Payne, OCAD University; and John Latour, Artex. This year, 12 nominations were received for the award.
